ADMISSION TO B.PHARM COURSES-2021
SECOND ROUND MOP UP ALLOTMENT LIST PUBLISHED

Mop up Allotment to fill up the vacant seats in B.Pharm course has been published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. The Mop up Allotment list has been published on the basis of the online options registered by the candidates from 22.04.2022 to 25.04.2022, 4.00 PM.

The Allotment Memo will be available in the 'Candidate Portal'. The details of Mop Up allotment of candidates such as Name, Roll Number, Allotted Course, Allotted College, Category of Allotment, Fee details etc. are available in the Home Page of candidates and also in the Allotment Memo.

Candidates who receive an allotment afresh through this Mop up Allotment should remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the allotted college and should join the college concerned from **03.05.2022 to 05.05.2022, 2.00 PM**.

Candidates who get allotment can download the 'Data Sheet' containing the basic details by clicking the menu item '**Data Sheet**' available in the Home Page. The printout of the Data Sheet, Allotment Memo and other required documents mentioned in Prospectus clause 11.7.1 are to be produced before the college authorities at the time of admission.

If the candidates who have already been admitted to B.Pharm course in Government Colleges through previous allotments conducted by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, get an allotment through Mop up Allotment, their previous allotment will stand cancelled. The Mop up registration fee of those candidates who do not join the college within the stipulated time after getting allotment through Mop up Allotment and the fee of those candidates who lapse seats after joining the college, will be considered as penalty. Penalty will also be applicable to those candidates, who lapse the B. Pharm seats after the Mop up Allotment, as per KEAM 2021 Prospectus clause 12.2.4 (c).

If any stray vacancy exist in B. Pharm course after the Mop up Allotment, it will be filled up through Stray Vacancy filling. Those candidates who are already admitted in

B.Pharm/Medical/Medical Allied courses through previous allotments and those candidates who got an allotment through the Second Round Mop up Allotment for B.Pharm or the Mop up allotments for Medical/Medical Allied courses will not be considered for Stray Vacancy Allotment.
