ALLOTMENT TO PG MEDICAL COURSES- 2022
SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT
FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION/REGISTRATION/
DELETION/REARRANGEMENT AVAILABLE

The second phase of Centralized allotment to Post Graduate Medical Degree Courses for the academic year 2022 in the State commences from **17.10.2022**. The newly included courses/seats shall also to be filled up in this phase of allotment.

Option Confirmation is mandatory

Option confirmation is compulsory to participate in Phase2. Option registration will be available only to the new courses added to the list at this stage. If a candidate is allotted a seat in the first round and joined the allotted seat, his/her higher options will be retained and all those options listed below the allotted option will automatically be deleted thus enabling only up gradation/retention in the same seat. If a candidate joined in a seat in Phase 1 does not give confirmation of option in the Phase 2 he will not be considered for up gradation in Phase 2, but the seat joined in Phase 1 will be retained. So if a candidate joined in Phase 1 does not want up gradation in Phase 2, he/she may not confirm options or after confirmation, delete all options registered. All candidates included in the Kerala merit list will be given facility to register options to the new courses added.

Candidates included in the State merit list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can log in to the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in and then click the link '**PG Medical 2022-Candidate Portal**' to access their home page. Candidates can re-arrange/delete their existing higher order options and also register fresh options to the newly included courses after clicking the

‘**Confirm**’ button available therein.

Following candidates are eligible to participate in the Second phase of allotment by clicking the ‘**Confirm**’ button available in the home page of the Candidate Portal.

- Candidates who have received an allotment in the first phase and got admitted to the allotted colleges and continue in their admitted status.
- Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase, and who want to be considered for the second phase of allotment.
- Candidates who wish to register fresh options for the newly included Colleges-courses in the second phase of allotment.

Candidates who will be excluded from Phase 2 State Counselling:

- A candidate who was allotted a seat in Phase 1 of State counselling but did not join the allotted seat.*
- A candidate who joined the allotted seat in Phase 1 of State counselling but after that vacated the seat.*
- A candidate who has been admitted in Round 2 of All India counselling

** But they can register options for the new Colleges- courses added in this phase*

The schedule for the second phase of allotment is given below:

17.10.2022	Website opens for enabling Online Option Confirmation, rearrangement/deletion of existing higher options and for registration of fresh options to the newly included colleges-courses.
26.10.2022, 10.00AM	Facility for Online Option Confirmation and rearrangement/deletion/registration of options ends.
28.10.2022	Publication of second phase allotment
31.10.2022 to 2.11.2022, 3.00PM	All candidates who get an allotment should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and pay the fee at the colleges.
2.11.2022, 4.00PM	College authorities shall have to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates to the CEE through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS)

If a candidate has been allotted a seat in the first phase and after the second

phase of allotment is retained in the same seat he/she need not do the joining process again and shall be considered as joined in the Second round if he/she continues in the admitted status after the last date of joining specified for the second phase.

A candidate joined in Phase I of State allotment, if desires to vacate the seat, he/she may do so without any penalty till one day prior to the last date of option registration to the IInd phase of State allotment.

A candidate joined in the Second round is ineligible to participate in further rounds of counseling. Surrender of seats will not be permitted. This is also in line with the regulations issued by National Medical Commission wherein a candidate admitted in All India or State second round will not be considered for further phases of All India or State counseling. The list of candidates admitted as on the last date of admission in Phase 2 will be forwarded to MCC as the list of candidates ineligible to participate in any further rounds of All India or State counseling.

Penalty Conditions in Phase 2:

- If a candidate does not join the allotted seat in Phase 2 or vacates the joined seat allotted in Phase 1 or 2 after Phase 2, and before the notification for option registration to Mop-up allotment is published he/she may exit with forfeiture of any Security deposit paid earlier. This will not be refunded and will be considered as a penalty. Those candidates who vacate seat (allotted in Round 1 or round 2), after the last date of joining of Round 2 will not be considered for further rounds of counseling.
- If a candidate vacates phase 1 or phase 2 joined seats after the notification for Option registration for Mop-up allotment is published, he/she shall have to pay an amount equivalent to 10% of the annual tuition fee as penalty to the CEE and also the Security Deposit paid to CEE will not be refunded. He /she will not be considered for further rounds of counseling.
- The conditions for the subsequent phases- Mop-up and Stray vacancy filling rounds are detailed in the Prospectus.

Candidates allotted to courses, shall remit the prescribed fee at the college and take admission in the college-course allotted as per the schedule prescribed by

the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. Candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission. The fee of Self-financing medical colleges is as per the fee fixed by ASC for the academic year 2021-22 and is subject to change and the candidate is liable to pay fee at the revised rate as and when fixed by ASC/Govt. for the academic year 2022-23.

There is also an enhancement of seats in the existing courses in the following Colleges. In Sree Gokulam Medical College and Research Foundation, Thiruvananthapuram there is an increase in 4 seats in MS Obstetrics & Gynaecology, 4 seats in MS General Surgery and 6 seats in MD General Medicine. In Pushpagiri Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Thiruvalla there is an increase in 2 seats in MD Respiratory Medicine. In Dr.Somervell Memmorial CSI Medical College & Hospital, Karakonam, there is

an increase in 2 seats in MS Orthopaedics and 1 seat in MD Radiodiagnosis.
