ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL COURSES-2022
ONLINE FINAL MOP UP ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The Online Final Mop up Allotment to the P G Medical (Degree) courses 2022, after addressing the valid complaints received on the provisional allotment list published on 21.11.2022, to fill up vacant seats in the Government Medical Colleges in the State, Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and Private Self Financing Medical colleges is published in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**.

As per clause 10.2.3 of the Prospectus for admission to PG Medical Courses the followings types of candidates have been excluded in the Mop up allotment.

- i. Those candidates who are admitted in an All India or State seat (through allotment in the first or second phase/round)
- ii. Those candidates who have vacated their seats (allotted in phase 1 or phase 2) after the last date of joining for phase 2 and
- iii. Those candidates who are allotted seats through All India Mop up allotment were excluded in the State Mop up phase.

To view the Allotment Result, candidates should log on to the '**PG Medical 2022-Candidate Portal**' by submitting their Application Number and Password. Then by clicking on the link '**Allotment Result**', candidates can view their Allotment Result. It is necessary to take the printout of Allotment Memo. The allotted candidate should report for joining at the allotted colleges from **24.11.2022 to 25.11.2022, 4.00 PM** along with required documents specified in the Allotment Memo and Prospectus.

Course once allotted in the online Mop-up Round shall be final. Surrender of seats after allotment in the online Mop up Round will not be permitted. The mop up

registration fee of those candidates who do not join the seat allotted through Mop up Round will be treated as penalty and will not be refunded. Those candidates who vacate the seat admitted after Mop up Allotment will be liable to pay Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lakhs only) liquidated damages in addition to registration fee as penalty to CEE. Candidates who are allotted a seat in the mop-up allotment (irrespective of the admission status) will not be eligible for any subsequent allotments.

In case vacancies exist/new vacancies arise after Mop up Allotment, these will also be filled in the subsequent phase that is Stray Vacancy Filling Round based on the options given for the Mop up allotment. The Guidelines for Stray Vacancy Filling round will be notified later.

All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at **5.00 PM on 25.11.2022.**

***Note:**, The service quota seats have not been included in this Mop up round.*
