ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL COURSES, KERALA- 2022
SECOND ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The Second allotment to the PG Medical Courses-2022 in the Government Medical Colleges in the State, Regional Cancer Centre(RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and Private Self Financing Medical Colleges is published. This allotment is based on the rank in the Kerala State Merit List & Category list and on the basis of options filed by the candidates. The allotment has been done by excluding those candidates admitted up to Round 2 of All India counselling as per the guidelines issued by MCC and NMC.(List of ineligible candidates is published in the website).

The allotment result is available in the 'Candidate Portal' in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in. To view the allotment result, candidates should log on to the 'PG Medical 2022- Candidate Portal' by submitting their Application Number and Password. Then by clicking on the link 'Allotment Result', candidates can view their allotment result. Allotment Memo and Data Sheet are available in the Candidate Portal. Candidates are advised to take copies of Allotment Memo and keep it for future reference as the Memo will not be available in the Portal once the allotment process is over.

The allotted candidates should report physically for joining at the allotted colleges from 01.11.2022 to 03.11.2022, 3.00 PM with Allotment Memo, and Data Sheet and the required documents specified in the Allotment Memo and Prospectus. The prescribed fee should be remitted at the allotted college during admission. All the College authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) before 4.00 PM on 03.11.2022.

Note: Those candidates who do not join the Colleges allotted within the stipulated time will lose their allotment.

Conditions of Exit and Guidelines for Mop-up Allotment

If a candidate has been allotted a seat in the first phase and after the second phase of allotment is retained in the same seat he/she need not do the joining process again and shall be considered as joined in the Second round if he/she continues in the admitted status after the last date of joining specified for the second phase.

A candidate joined in the Second round is ineligible to participate in further rounds of counseling. Surrender of seats will not be permitted. This is also in line with the regulations issued by National Medical Commission wherein a candidate admitted in All India or State second round will not be considered for further phases of All India or State counseling. The list of candidates admitted as on the last date of admission in Phase 2 will be forwarded to MCC as the list of candidates ineligible to participate in any further rounds of All India or State counseling.

Penalty Conditions in Phase 2:

- If a candidate does not join the allotted seat in Phase 2 or vacates the joined seat allotted in Phase 1 or 2 after Phase 2 and before the notification for Option registration for Mop-up allotment is published he/she may exit with forfeiture of any Security deposit paid earlier. This will not be refunded and will be considered as a penalty.
- Those candidates who vacate seat (allotted in Round 1 or round 2), after the last date of joining of Round 2 will not be considered for further rounds of counseling.
- If a candidate vacates phase 1 or phase 2 joined seats after the notification for Option registration for Mop-up allotment is published, he/she shall have to pay an amount equivalent to 10% of the annual tuition fee as penalty to the CEE and also the Security Deposit paid to CEE will not be refunded. He /she will not be considered for further rounds of counseling.

Mop-up Round and Option Registration

After the first two rounds of counseling, Mop up counseling will start, which also offers fresh option registration to candidates. The net vacant seats due to Un-allotted/Non joining of Round 2 will be published. Candidates shall register options to any seats they wish to join if allotted irrespective of the vacancy status notified as any vacancy that may arise during the counseling will also be filled based on these options. As applicable category

conversions of seats will take place in the mop-up allotment, while registering options for the mop-up allotment, candidates are advised to take into account those probable vacancies too that may arise due to the applicable category conversion rules. The options registered in this Mop-up phase will be considered for Stray vacancy seat filling also.

Candidates who will be excluded in State Mop-up phase:

1. Those candidates who are admitted in an All India or State seat(through allotment in the first or second phase/round)
2. Those candidates who have vacated their seats (allotted in phase 1 or phase2) after the last date of joining for Phase 2
3. Those candidates who are allotted seats through All India Mop-up allotment.

Penalty Conditions in Mop-up Phase :

From the Mop up phase onwards, restriction has been implemented to candidates in order to avoid lapsing of seats and holding of AIQ seats and State quota seats thus blocking seats. A candidate allotted a seat in Mop-up round in State counseling shall be ineligible to participate in any further counseling. Hence candidates are advised to exercise due diligence in exercising their options and do not file unwanted options to seats in which they do not wish to pursue studies. As a measure to prevent this, a separate Registration fee will be implemented to all candidates, who register fresh options in Mop up Phase.

- Registration fee amounting to the annual tuition fee of the seat opted if opted only for Government seat or an amount of Rs.2,00,000 (Rupees Two Lakhs only) if opted also for a seat in Private Self financing Medical College may be set as registration fee. For SC/ST/OE and other candidates who are eligible for fee concession, the registration fee for Govt./Pvt. Medical college seats will be half of the above amounts respectively.
- The registration fee paid for Mop-up allotment will be adjusted in the fee of the course if the candidate gets an allotment or else will be refunded after the end of counseling.
- The registration fee paid for Mop-up phase of those candidates who do not join the seat allotted in Mop-up or stray vacancy filling allotment will be treated as penalty and will not be refunded.
- A candidate who joins a seat allotted through mop-up allotment and then vacates the

seat for any reason will be liable to pay an amount of Rs.2,00,000 (Rupees Two Lakhs) in addition to the registration fee as penalty to CEE as this is the last round of CAP. This will be imposed irrespective of their category/reservation/financial status.
