MEDICAL P G DEGREE / DIPLOMA COURSES, KERALA - 2014 THIRD ROUND OF COUNSELING (Revised Notification)

The third round of counseling to fill up the vacant State Quota seats including Service Quota seats and the seats in Government Controlled Self Financing/Private Self Financing Medical colleges in Medical P G courses - 2014 will be conducted on 22.06.2014 (Sunday) at the Old Auditorium inside the Medical College campus, Thiruvananthapuram. In the light of the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India extending the date of surrender of unavailed All India Quota seats, all the candidates included in the Rank list/Category lists prepared and published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations are eligible to participate in the allotment process. The counseling to the General Quota seats will be based on the various merit and category lists published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and that to the Service Quota seats will be based on the seniority-wise lists of service candidates prepared by the Heads of Departments concerned and approved by the Post Graduate Selection Committee.

The service candidates are directed to report at the venue of the personal counseling at **9.30 am** on **22.06.2014**. The General Quota candidates are directed to report at the venue of the personal counseling at **1.30 pm on 22.06.2014**. The candidates appearing for the counseling shall produce all their original certificates to prove their academic eligibility along with the Admit Card issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The candidates who have taken and still holding a seat under All India Quota or having any other admissions can also participate in the counseling subject to the condition that they should produce the records to prove that they have been admitted under All India Quota and an undertaking, to the effect that they will produce the original certificates at the time of admission, will have to be given by such candidates.

The vacancies created at the time of allotment will be filled up then and there itself according to merit and eligibility.

The candidates who get allotment will be issued with an allotment memo and the fee to be paid will be shown in the memo. The candidates who get an allotment in the Government Medical Colleges should pay the fees shown in the allotment memo at the venue of allotment itself (Rs 45,000/- for General candidates and Rs.1000/- for SC/ST candidates). In the case of candidates allotted to a Government Controlled Self Financing Medical College/ Private Self Financing Medical College, a general category candidate should pay an amount of Rs 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand only) at the venue of allotment itself, as token of having accepted the allotment. The balance amount of fees should be paid at the college concerned at the time of admission. For an SC/ST candidate, the token amount to be paid at the venue of allotment will be Rs.5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only).

<u>Important:</u> The candidates who are allotted with a subject in the counseling and who discontinues the course on any reason after this counseling shall be liable to pay the liquidated damages as per Clause 13-2 of the prospectus.
