**SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO MBBS/BDS COURSES**  
**FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION**

The activities related to the Second Phase of Allotment to MBBS/BDS Courses for the State Quota Seats available in Government and Self Financing Colleges will begin on **08.03.2022**. As per MCC guidelines, those candidates who are admitted to All India Quota Seats will not be considered to participate in this phase of allotment.

**Online Option Confirmation is mandatory**

Those Candidates who want their higher order options in MBBS/BDS courses to be considered in the Second Phase of Allotment, shall have to log into their Home Page and confirm their options by clicking the ‘ **Confirm** ’ button available therein. After Online Option confirmation, the candidates can re-arrange their higher order options/ delete the unwanted options, Courses/Colleges if applicable, from **08.03.2022 to 11.03.2022, 10.00 AM**, through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. Online option confirmation is mandatory for those who have got admission and those who haven't got any allotment as per the first phase allotment, to be considered in the Second Phase Allotment. Those who do not confirm their options after First Phase of Admission, the admission in the First Phase will be retained.

On the basis of options received up to **10.00 AM on 11.03.2022** , the Second Phase Allotment to MBBS/BDS courses will be published in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** on **14.03.2022**. Candidates who receive allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their Allotment Memo and remit the Fee/Balance Fee (if applicable) payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by way of online payment at any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala on any date from **15.03.2022, 4.00 PM to 19.03.2022, 2.00 PM**. The list of Post Offices having facility for fee payment is available in the website. After remitting the Fee/Balance Fee (if applicable), the candidates should join the Course/College allotted from **16.03.2022 to 19.03.2022, 2.00 PM**.

**DETAILED SCHEDULE OF THE ALLOTMENT**

<b>08.03.2022</b>	Website opens for Online Option confirmation and for enabling re-arrangement of higher order options/deletion of unwanted options for MBBS/BDS courses
<b>11.03.2022, 10.00AM</b>	Time for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/deletion of options ends.
<b>14.03.2022</b>	<b>Publication of Second Allotment</b>
<b>15.03.2022, 4.00 PM to 19.03.2022, 2.00 PM</b>	Candidates who receive Allotment should remit the Fee/Balance Fee (if applicable) payable to CEE by way of online payment or at any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala.
<b>16.03.2022 to 19.03.2022, 2.00 PM</b>	Time to report before the College authorities to join the allotted College/Course for MBBS/BDS.
<b>19.03.2022, 3.00 PM</b>	All College authorities should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS).

**FEES**

The details of Fee for MBBS/BDS Courses, in various colleges is available in the website. Fee structure in the case of Self Financing Colleges is subject to the orders of the Fee Regulatory Committee /Government/Hon'ble High Court/Hon'ble Supreme Court. As per the Interim order in the WP(c)No. 4297of 2022(J) dated. 09.02.2022, the fee for Believers Church Medical College fixed by the Fee Regulatory Committee for the year 2021-22 will be provisional and will be subject to the final order in the Writ Petition. The College authorities should make it clear while issuing receipts to the students for the fees paid.

**TOKEN FEES**

- Those candidates who get allotment to MBBS Course in Self-Financing Colleges should pay an amount of **Rs.3 lakhs** and those candidates who get Allotment to NRI quota seats should remit fee of **Rs.5 lakhs** to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- Those candidates who get Allotment to BDS Course (including NRI quota seats) should pay an amount of Rs.1 Lakh to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- Candidates who get Allotment to seats in Government Colleges for MBBS/BDS Courses should pay the complete Fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sreechitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home should remit Rs.1000/- as Token Fees to the Commissioner for Entrance

Examinations. However, if such students are allotted under Minority/NRI quota seats in Self-Financing Medical/Dental Colleges, they will have to remit the token fee prescribed above and they will not be eligible for any fee concession.

**Note:**

1. Candidates are advised to file options to the Courses/Colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted, at the time of Registration of Options.
2. The time allotted for NRI candidates who have been provisionally given NRI status as per the directions of Admission Supervisory Committee has ended on 02.03.2022. Thus those candidates who failed to upload the documents within the stipulated time have lost the allotment, if any received in the NRI quota through the first phase allotment and the provisional NRI category claim given also stand cancelled.

Vacancy in MBBS course, if any, that exists after the Second Phase Allotment will be filled up through Mop Up /Spot allotment. In Mop Up Counselling transfer will not be permitted from a Govt. Medical College to another Govt. Medical College and from a Self-Financing Medical College to another Self-Financing Medical College. But transfer will be permitted from Self-Financing Medical College to Govt. Medical Colleges. Transfer from NRI seats to Non-NRI seats shall also be permitted between two Self-Financing colleges or in the same College.
