THREE YEAR LL.B COURSE, 2019-20
SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT
ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION IS MANDATORY

The activities related to the Second and Final phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to Three Year LL.B Course in the 4 Government Law Colleges and the Private Self-financing Law Colleges in the State which have entered into seat sharing agreement with the Government for the year 2019-20, commenced on **20.07.2019 (Saturday)**.

Candidates who have received an allotment and taken admission in the first phase and who want their existing higher order options to be considered for the second phase shall have to compulsorily confirm their online options, by clicking the 'Confirm' button available in their home page provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase also shall have to perform Online Option Confirmation for being considered in the second phase.

After **Online Option Confirmation**, the candidates can change the priority of existing higher options and delete the unwanted higher options, if desired. The facility for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/deletion of options will be available in the above website from **20.07.2019 to 24.07.2019, 1 pm**. **Those who do not confirm their higher options online within the stipulated time will not be considered for this phase of allotment.** But the present admission, if any, of such candidates after the first phase of allotment shall be retained. The requests for option confirmation/re-arrangement/deletion of options received via Post/Fax/e-mail/Hand delivery will not be considered under any circumstances.

The schedule for the second phase of allotment is given below:

20.07.2019	Website opens for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/ deletion of options
24.07.2019, 1 pm	Time for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/ deletion of options ends
24.07.2019	Second Phase of Allotment Publication
25.07.2019 to 27.07.2019, 4 pm	All candidates who get an allotment shall remit the fee, if any, to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as shown in the Allotment Memo at selected branches of Head Post Office or by way of Online Payment and should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and Fee Receipt. Balance fees, if any, shall have to be paid at the college at the time of admission.
27.07.2019, 5 pm	Principals of colleges to approve and submit the admission list through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) in the College portal
29.07.2019	Classes to commence

In the case of candidates getting fresh allotment to Government Law Colleges, the entire fee amount shall have to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. In the case of candidates getting fresh allotment to Private Self-Financing Law Colleges, Rs.5000/- shall have to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and the balance tuition fee, other fees and the deposits should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission. The relevant Government Orders detailing the annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits is available in the website for reference.

Fee Exemption:

Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC/Communities eligible for educational concessions as is given to OEC/Candidates eligible for fee concession as per GO(Ms) No. 25/2005/SCSTDD dated: 20.06.2005/Children of Fisherman/Inmates of Sri Chithra home, Nirbhaya home & Juvenile home allotted under Government Quota are exempted from payment of fees.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 6 of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

Important:

1. Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates after the second allotment shall lose their allotment as well as their higher order options. They will not be eligible for further claims in the future online allotments, if any, under Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).
2. Candidates who receive a change of allotment to their higher options in the second phase of allotment will automatically lose their admission in the first phase and they should obtain the T.C, relevant documents and amount remitted at the time of admission from their currently admitted college and should join the newly allotted college on the above specified dates.
3. Candidates are advised not to retain unnecessary options to courses/colleges where they do not wish to join, if allotted.
