<u>NOTIFICATION</u> <u>ALLOTMENT / ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE MEDICAL</u> (DEGREE / DIPLOMA) COURSES, KERALA -2022 <u>ONLINE APPLICATIONS INVITED</u>

Applications are invited from the candidates who have qualified in the NEET-PG 2022, for admission to **Post Graduate Medical (Degree/Diploma) Courses, 2022** in the State Quota seats in Government Medical Colleges and Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and to the entire seats including Minority Quota and NRI Quota seats available in Private Self Financing Medical Colleges in Kerala. The last date for submission of Online applications is **20.08.2022, 10:00 AM**.

Allotment of seats from the rank list for all courses in Self Financing Medical colleges will be made in accordance with orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Hon'ble High Court of Kerala or the orders of the Government of Kerala/Government of India or as per the law in existence at the time of the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).

Eligibility for Admission:

- a. Academic: Applicants should be in possession of MBBS degree or provisional MBBS pass certificate recognized by NMC (MCI) with MBBS qualification registered permanently or provisionally with NMC (MCI) or State Medical Council and have completed one year of internship or are likely to complete it on or before 31st May 2022. Admission to such candidates will be given only after they have obtained registration of T.C. Medical Council.
- b. *Nativity:* Applicants should have satisfied any of the following conditions.
 - i. Applicant should be an Indian Citizen of Kerala origin.
 - Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)/Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) will be considered only for the NRI seats as per Gazette of India dated. 04.03.2021. They will not be eligible for the general merit seats or any type of reservation other than NRI quota.
 - iii.Candidates who are sons/daughters of Non-Keralite parents, who have

obtained MBBS Degree from any of the Medical Colleges in the State of Kerala. But they will not be eligible for Communal/Special/Persons with Disability reservation benefits.

(c) Age: There is no Upper age limit for admission to PG Medical courses 2022 with the following exceptions.

- i. For Medical Education service quota candidates, the upper age limit will be 47 years as on the date of notification for application invitation by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- ii. For Health service quota and Insurance Medical service quota candidates, the upper age limit will be 45 years as on the date of notification for application invitation by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

(d) Qualifying criteria:- All candidates seeking admission to Post Graduate Medical Degree/Diploma courses (including service candidates for P G Diploma courses) in the State of Kerala for the academic year 2022-23 shall have to qualify the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test for Post Graduate Courses (NEET PG-2022) conducted by the National Board of Examination, New Delhi. In order to be eligible for admission in any Post Graduate Medical course in 2022-23, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain a minimum of marks as given in the table below.

Mode of selection

The selection of the candidates shall be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala on the basis of NEET PG 2022 rank list subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions as in Clause 4 of the Prospectus. The admission to the State quota seats in Govt.Medical colleges and RCC (Regional Cancer Centre), Thiruvananthapuram and to the entire PG Medical

(Degree/Diploma) seats including Minority quota and NRI quota in Self financing Medical colleges in the State for the year 2022-23 shall be done through a common counselling to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from the State rank list.

The selection and allotment of seats including those under Service Quota will be made by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations through a Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) as per **Clause 10** of the Prospectus for admission to Medical Post Graduate Degree/Diploma courses-2022, approved by the Government of Kerala.

Submission of Applications and Application Fee: All candidates seeking admission to the PG Medical Degree/Diploma Courses 2022 can apply in the Online application form till 20.08.2022, 10.00AM provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. They shall also remit the required fee by way of Online Payment or by way of e-challan, the printout of which is available during the submission of online application. Payment through e-challan can be made in cash at any of the Head/Sub Post Offices in Kerala. After remitting the required application fee all necessary certificates/documents as proof for various claims shall also be uploaded within the stipulated time.

<u>There is no need to send printout of the application or any documents to the</u> <u>Commissioner for Entrance Examinations</u>.

The in-service candidates should send the printout of the application along with printout of the uploaded documents and the required service details to the Head of the department concerned, so as to reach him/her before 04.00 PM on 20.08.2022.

Application Fee for General Candidates and Service Quota candidates is **Rs.1000**/- (Rupees Thousand only) and in the case of SC/ST candidates and those eligible for SC/ST benefits as per G.O.(Ms) No.25/2005/SCSTDD dated 20.06.2005 is **Rs.500**/- (Rupees Five hundred only).Service quota candidates will have to pay an additional amount of Rs.1000/- if they apply for general seat also. Application fee once remitted will not be refunded. The Prospectus can be downloaded from the website. The hard copy of the application form and Prospectus will not be available from the Medical Colleges or from the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Last date and time for the submission of online application

All candidates including in-service candidates seeking admission to the courses should submit the online application and should upload the required documents/certificates mentioned in clause 8 of the Prospectus before **10.00 AM on 20.08.2022.** Defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard. Also the claims without necessary proofs will not be accepted.

Admission under NRI Quota

The Candidates seeking admission to the NRI quota seats in Self-Financing Medical Colleges in the State shall upload the following Certificates/documents during the submission of online application.

- 1. Passport copy and Visa attested by the Embassy/Green Card/Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) documents of their respective sponsors. The job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the above documents. The validity of the Visa should be up to the closing date of admission for Medical course.
- 2. In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the above documents the candidate has to produce Employment certificate of the sponsor attested by the Embassy/Consulate authorities.
- 3. Certificate clearly establishing the relationship of the sponsor with the candidate shall be obtained from the Revenue authorities as per the G.O (Ms) No. 243/14/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014.

Note: Relationship should clearly be established. In case relationship is mentioned as Niece/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt only in the space provided for in the certificate, the Village Officer should give an explanation of the relation in the certificate itself. Niece/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt should be explained with a clear relationship. The relationship link should be clearly explained. Certificates showing mere Niece/Cousin/Uncle/Aunt without establishing a clear relationship link will be rejected. Candidates shall verify the certificate properly before submitting online. However the relationship between the candidate and his/her father/mother which are recorded in the educational certificates maintained in the usual course of transaction by the competent authorities shall be accepted.

- 4. The candidate shall produce the sworn affidavit from the Sponsor in a stamp paper worth Rs. 200/-. The same shall also be notarized by the Notary Public, disclosing that the student is dependent on the sponsor and all expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the Sponsor.
- 5. If the candidate is an OCI, proof of OCI status and domicile in a State/India alone may be submitted and without being required to upload documents establishing NRI status, as per the interim order issued in WP(C) No.1397/2020 and subject to the final outcome of this petition.

Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the last date for submission of the application.

Data Sheet

Candidates eligible for allotment/admission to the courses will be issued Data Sheet which can be downloaded from the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** from the date which will be notified later.

Candidates may go through the various provisions of the Prospectus for admission to Medical Post Graduate Degree/Diploma courses-2022, available on the official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in before filling up the Online application forms.
