# CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT TO THREE YEAR LL.B COURSE, 2019-20 ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED

The Centralised Allotment Process for admission to the Three Year LL.B Course in the four Government Law Colleges and to the 50% Government seats in 8 Self-financing Law Colleges in the State for the year 2019-20 commenced on **12.07.2019 (Friday)**.

Candidates included in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register their options online through the website <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u> from **12.07.2019** to **16.07.2019**, **1 pm**. Candidates may enter their Application Number & Password in the link **'Three Year LL.B 2019 - Candidate Portal'** provided in the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the link **'Option Registration'**, candidates can register their options for colleges online. The first allotment based on the online options received up to 1 pm on 16.07.2019 will be published in the evening on **16.07.2019**. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges on any date from **17.07.2019** to **19.07.2019**.

**Candidates whose results are withheld in the rank list due to various reasons can also register online options.** If relevant documents are not uploaded by such candidates till 14.07.2019, 5 pm, their options will not be considered for the allotment process.

Candidates who fail to register their options online will not be considered for allotment under any circumstances. Options submitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by E-mail/Fax/Post/Hand delivery will not be processed or considered on any account for the allotment of seats.

In the case of candidates getting allotment to Government Law Colleges, the entire fee amount shall have to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. In the case of candidates getting allotment to Private Self-Financing Law Colleges, **Rs.5000/-** shall have to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and the balance tuition fee, other fees and the deposits should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission. The relevant Government Orders detailing the annual tuition fee, other fees and the deposits is available in the website for reference.

### Fee Exemption:

Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC/Communities eligible for educational concessions as is given to OEC/Candidates eligible for fee concession as per GO(Ms) No. 25/2005/SCSTDD dated: 20.06.2005/Children of Fisherman/Inmates of Sri Chithra home, Nirbhaya home & Juvenile home allotted under Government Quota are exempted from payment of fees.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per **Clause 6** of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

### Documents to be produced at the time of admission

- i) Candidate's Data Sheet downloaded from the website of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- ii) Allotment memo issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- iii) SSLC or any relevant school records/birth certificate/passport/other valid document to prove date of birth in original.
- iv) Original Mark list and Pass Certificate of the qualifying examination.
- v) Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate from the institution where the candidate studied last.
- vi) Four copies of recent passport size photograph.
- vii) The applicant who is employed or trainee in Government/Quasi Government/Banks etc. shall, at the time of interview, produce a relieving order and a certificate of good conduct from the Head of the Institution where the candidate was employed.
- viii) Candidates who passed their qualifying examination from Universities/Boards outside the State shall produce an "Eligibility Certificate" from the concerned University in Kerala, to the effect that the qualifying examination has been recognised by the University.
- ix) The student who qualifies from other Universities should produce migration certificate at the time of admission.
- x) Originals of all the uploaded documents/certificates (to prove nativity /reservation/fee concession).
- xi) Any other certificates/documents required to be furnished as per the prospectus/notifications/allotment memo.

Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment as well as their higher order options. The will not be eligible for further claims in the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).

**Note:** Candidates are advised not to give unnecessary options to courses/colleges where they do not wish to join, if allotted.
