Entrance Examination for Admission to Post Graduate Degree Courses in Nursing (M.Sc. Nursing)- 2021 APPLICATIONS INVITED

 Applications are invited for the Computer Based Entrance Examination for admission to Post Graduate Degree Courses in Nursing (M.Sc. Nursing) 2021 in the Government Nursing Colleges at Thiruvananthapuram, Alappuzha, Kottayam, Thrissur, Kozhikode, Kannur and Government seats in various Self Financing colleges in the following Specialties.

[i] Medical Surgical Nursing [ii] Community Health Nursing [iii] Child Health Nursing

[iv] Obstetrics & Gynaecology Nursing [v] Mental Health Nursing

Candidates can apply through the official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u> from 08.12.2021 to 16.12.2021, 3.00 pm.

2. Eligibility for Admission :

- (i) Nativity: Applicants should have satisfied any of the following conditions :
 - I. Indian Citizen of Kerala origin.
 - II. Candidates, who are sons/daughters of Non-Keralite parents and have obtained B.Sc. Nursing degree from any of the Nursing Colleges in Kerala State.
 - III. Candidates who are not of Kerala origin but have been a resident of Kerala for a period of not less than 5 years. Non Keralite applicants will not be eligible for communal/Persons with Disability (PD) reservation benefits. (See clause 7.1 of the prospectus)
- (ii) Academic Qualifications:
- (a) Candidate should have passed the Bachelor Degree in Nursing of Kerala, Calicut, Mahatma Gandhi, Cochin, Kannur Universities or Kerala University of Health Sciences or regular course of other universities recognized by KUHS. Only candidates who have passed a regular BSc Nursing Degree program with minimum of 55% aggregate marks will be eligible for admission.

Or

Candidates who have passed the Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing of Kerala, Calicut, Mahatma Gandhi, Kannur Universities or Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) or regular course of other universities recognized by KUHS, after acquiring General Nursing and Midwifery Course with +2 Science Subjects. Only candidates who have passed a regular Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing degree program with minimum of 55% aggregate marks will be eligible for admission. (Those with Distance/Correspondence Degree course is not eligible for MSc Nursing admission)

- (b) The candidate should have obtained registration with the Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council and registration certificate has to be produced at the time of admission. Candidates who have studied outside Kerala shall have to produce registration certificate of the concerned Nursing Council of the state from where they have qualified at the time of admission. The selected candidates should produce their registration certificate in original obtained from Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council at the time of admission.
- (c) Candidates who have passed B.Sc. Degree in Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing (Regular Course) from Universities outside Kerala and any of the Deemed Universities should

produce the equivalency certificate from any of the Universities in Kerala, at the time of counseling.

- (d) Relaxation in Marks: SC/ST, SEBC and PD candidates will have 5% Relaxation in academic eligibility marks.
- (e) <u>Experience:</u> Applicant should have completed one year of experience on the date of notification of inviting application (ie, 08.12.2021) in any hospital with average bed strength of one hundred inpatients or in a recognized School of Nursing or in a Community Health centre or internship/ Compulsory Nursing service, after registration with the respective State Nursing Council. (clause 7.2.2)
 - a) The experience of one year acquired by the candidates after registration from the respective State Nursing Councils within or outside Kerala, following successful completion of B.Sc Nursing course will only be counted for experience.
 - b) The period undergone by a candidate for completing the Post Basic B.Sc Nursing Course will not be reckoned for experience. Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc Nursing is essential.
 - c) Candidates have to produce the Certificate to prove their experience at the time of admission.
- 3. Age: The upper age limit for General candidates shall be 46 years and that for Service candidates shall be 49 years as on the date of notification of inviting application i.e. on 08.12.2021.
- 4. How to apply : All candidates including Service candidates seeking admission to the PG Nursing Courses 2021 should apply online from 08.12.2021 to 16.12.2021, 3.00 pm through the link 'PG Nursing 2021- Online Application' in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the CEE. While applying online, candidates should upload the scanned images of his /her recent Photo, Signature in jpeg format , proof of Date of birth and Nativity proof in pdf format along with the Online application within the above date. The other eligibility certificates and documents can be submitted online in pdf format upto 20.12.2021, 3.00 pm as per the instructions given in the Prospectus (clause 8.2.4). Print out of the Application Acknowledgement page or any other supporting documents need not be sent by post to the office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examination.

- Note: General quota candidates seeking admission in service quota shall have to pay an additional amount of Rs. 1050/- All candidates shall have to remit the required fee either by online payment gateway using internet banking/credit card/debit card or by using e-chellan payment in any of the Head /Sub Post Offices in Kerala. Application fee once remitted will not be refunded.
- 6. Service quota candidates: Service quota candidates in addition to applying online, should, forward a copy of the Application Acknowledgement page along with all required documents

including their service details to the Controlling Officer (DME/DHS/IMS) concerned as stipulated in clause 6.3 and 8.2.5 of the Prospectus, on or before 5 PM on16.12.2021. Service details need not be sent to the office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

- 7. Admit Cards : Admit cards of the candidates will be provided in the official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, www.cee.kerala.gov.in prior to the Computer Based Test. The date will be announced later.
- Entrance Examination : All Candidates including Service Quota candidates shall have to appear for the <u>Entrance Examination to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examination</u> <u>(CEE)</u>, <u>Kerala</u>. The Entrance examination will be a Computer Based Test of 2 hours duration with 200 Multiple Choice Questions. The date, time and details of venues of Online Entrance Examinations will be notified later.

The scheme of entrance examination, syllabus and the instructions to the candidates are available in clause 9 of the "Prospectus for Admission to PG Nursing (M.Sc. Nursing) -2021" approved by Government of Kerala.

- 9. Rank List: The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE), Kerala will publish the rank list of qualified candidates who appeared in the Entrance Examination (as per clause 11). Service quota candidates shall have to qualify by securing 40% marks in the Entrance Examination to include in the Service quota as stipulated in clause 11 of the prospectus.
- 10. Category list: The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE), Kerala will publish the category list of candidates including service quota as per the conditions as stipulated in clause 11 of the prospectus.
- 11. Allotment:-_The allotment of seats including those under Service Quota will be made by CEE through the Centralised Allotment Process as per clause 12 of the Prospectus for Admission to PG Nursing- 2021 approved by Government of Kerala.

Candidates may go through the "Prospectus for Admission to PG Nursing -2021", approved by the Government of Kerala, which is available in the official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, at <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u> before submitting online applications.
