ADMISSION TO THREE YEAR LL.B COURSE, 2019-20

SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The second and last phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to Three Year LL.B Courses in the 4 Government Law Colleges and Private Self Financing Law Colleges in the State which have entered into seat sharing agreement with the Government for the year 2019-20 is published herewith in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. The allotment is based on the online options available up to 1 pm on 24.07.2019.

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their Application number, and Password in the 'Three Year LL.B 2019 - Candidate Portal' provided in the above website. Then by clicking the menu item 'Allotment Result', candidates can download their Allotment Memo. The details such as candidate's name, roll number, allotment details, tuition fees, deposit if any etc. are available in the Allotment Memo. Candidates shall have to take a print out of the Allotment memo. Candidates can also log into their Home Page and click the Menu Item 'Data Sheet' for downloading the Data Sheet.

Candidates who receive fresh allotment or a change in allotment than the previous phase shall have to take a print out of the Allotment memo and remit the fee to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by way of Online Payment or at any of the selected Head Post Offices and should report for admission before the Principal of the allotted colleges on any date from 25.07.2019 to 27.07.2019, 4 pm along with the Allotment memo and original documents specified in Clause 18 of the Prospectus [For details, see notification dated 12.07.2019]. They should remit the balance fees, if any, as per Government orders in the allotted college at the time of admission.

All the College Principals should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at 5 pm on 27.07.2019.

The candidates who do not join the college within the stipulated time will lose their present allotment and also their higher order options. Also such candidates will not be considered for future online allotments, if any, under Centralised Allotment Process.

Note:-Candidates who receive a change of allotment to their higher options in the second phase of allotment will automatically lose their admission in the first phase and they should obtain the T.C, relevant documents and amount remitted at the time of admission from their currently admitted college and should join the newly allotted college on the above specified dates.
