Health & Family Welfare Department – Academic – Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram – Fees and admission of students to Post Graduate Medical (MD/MS/Diploma) courses during 2014-2015 – Sanction Accorded – Orders issued.

Read: - (1) Letter No.B2/24823/2013/DME dated 01.04.2014 from the Director of Medical Education, Thiruvananthapuram

(2) Agreement dated 29.04.2014 entered into the Principal, Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram and the Additional Secretary (Health & Family Welfare)

ORDER

Sanction is accorded to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for including Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram for allotment of students for admission to Post Graduate Medical (MD/MS/Diploma) Courses for the academic year 2014-2015, subject to the terms and conditions specified below.

Terms and Conditions: -

- 50% of total PG Medical (MD/MS/Diploma)seats sanctioned in the college will be filled up by the Government from the list prepared by the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations in accordance with merit and reservation principles followed by Government from time to time.
- 2. The Government shall furnish the list of the students to be admitted in the college by the educational agency and the educational agency concerned shall admit the students specified in the list. The students in the list will be given specific instructions as to the date and time of presentation before the college for admission, the amount of fees to be paid, and the records to be submitted at the time of admission. The educational agency shall admit the students who have complied with the instructions as certified by the Government. The Government shall furnish such list on or before 30th June 2014 or such other date as mutually agreed upon by the parties. The Managements concerned shall accept and admit the students accordingly following the above procedures but in any case not later than 5 PM on 30th June 2014. The Management concerned shall be entitled to fill those seats remaining unfilled by Government after the cut off date for admission to Government Merit Quota seats for the academic year 2014-15.

- 3. If any student is not admitted by the educational agency concerned for specific defects or for reasons what so ever, it shall intimate the Government the defects or reasons as the case may be and the Government shall rectify the defects or state the reasons for accepting the list or furnish a revised list which the management concerned shall accept and admit the students accordingly following the above procedures.
- 4. The educational agency concerned agrees to collect annual tuition fees for those 50% merit quota students during the entire course period at the rate specified below.

Signed and sealed receipts shall be given by the management/college for all students.

- 5. The annual tuition fee fixed shall be inclusive of all amounts collected as in the case of similarly situated students in Government Colleges. However, the educational agency concerned shall be entitled to collect such other statutorily permitted fees including University fees and charges and such other amounts collected from similarly situated students in Government colleges or the Government controlled Medical Colleges, which shall be specifically listed out and published each year, during the entire course of study. The educational agency concerned shall not collect any amount from any student so admitted, other than those specified above.
- 6. 50% of the total seats shall be Management quota seats to be filled by the educational agency on the basis of interse merit in the rank list of the Entrance Test for PG Medical Courses published by the Educational agency/Association. In the event of non availability of required number of candidates in the rank list prepared by the Educational agency/Association, other candidates who qualified in the All India Post Graduate Medical Entrance Examination-2014 (AIPGMEE-2014) shall be admitted. Out of the 50%, the Managements are entitled to fill up 15% of seats by the eligible students who are children/dependants of Non-Resident Indians, as per the conditions stipulated in GO(MS)No.34/2013/H&FWD dated 05.02.2013 and further orders in this regard if any, issued by Government from time to time.
- 7. In view of the representation of the educational agency with regard to the expenses incurred for establishing and administering and for further developing infrastructure and facilities in the college, the educational agency shall be entitled to collect annual fee for the 50% management quota students during the entire course period at the rate specified below.

Post Graduate Degree (Non-Clinical) - ₹ 4,80,000/-Post Graduate Diploma (Clinical) - ₹ 9,00,000/-

- 8. The seat sharing between the Educational agency and Government shall be as per the methodology fixed as per GO(Rt)No.2138/2011/H&FWD dated 02.06.2011.
- 9. The educational agency undertakes that no consideration in cash or kind other than those specified above shall be received, accepted or collected in any form whatsoever from any student admitted to college. It shall be the liability of the educational agency to redress complaints from the students, parents or interested parties on any matter other than those covered by the terms and conditions of the agreement.
- 10. The chart for distribution of Post Graduate Medical (MD/MS/Diploma) seats in Academy of Medical Sciences, Pariyaram, prepared by the Director of Medical Education based on the stipulations specified as per GO(Rt)No.2138/2011/H&FWD dated 02.06.2011 and forwarded vide letter read as 2nd paper above is approved herewith and annexured to this order.
